Upon graduation, Norma moved to California to do her part in the war effort. She became a welder and built ships at the San Diego ship yards.

After the war, Norma return home and resumed her job as a grocery clerk. Soon after she met her future husband Densal LaClef. Densal and Norma were married April 25, 1948.
