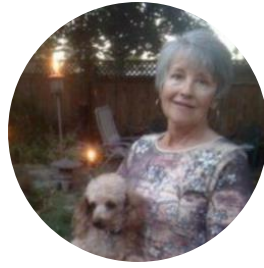

**N**ancy Davis Chapman, 65, died October 8, 2013, at her home in Oregon City surrounded by her family and friends after a courageous six-month battle against cancer.
