**A**ngela Marie Terwilliger, lovingly known to many as Angie, passed away peacefully in her sleep on March 6, 2026, in Oregon City, Oregon, at the age of 44 after lifelong complications from Vascular Ehlers-Danlos Syndrome.

Angela was born June 17, 1981, in Roseburg, Oregon, to Ron Terwilliger and Lydia Terwilliger. From the beginning, Angie had a spirit that was impossible to ignore—stubborn, strong, and incredibly funny. She carried a warmth and humor that could light up any room, and her laughter was something those who loved her will never forget.

Her fiery red hair, freckles, and spunky personality made her unforgettable, but it was her fierce loyalty, kindness, and the way she loved her family and friends that truly defined her. Though she did not have biological children, Angie held a special place in her heart for her stepdaughter, Tehya, and treasured the role she played in her life.

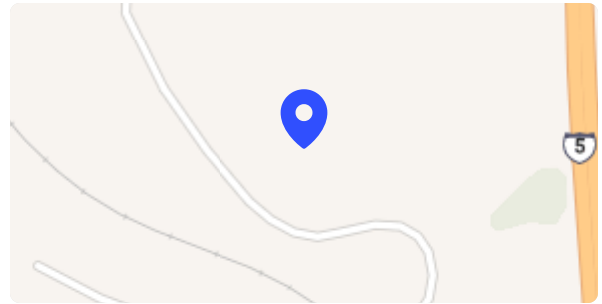
